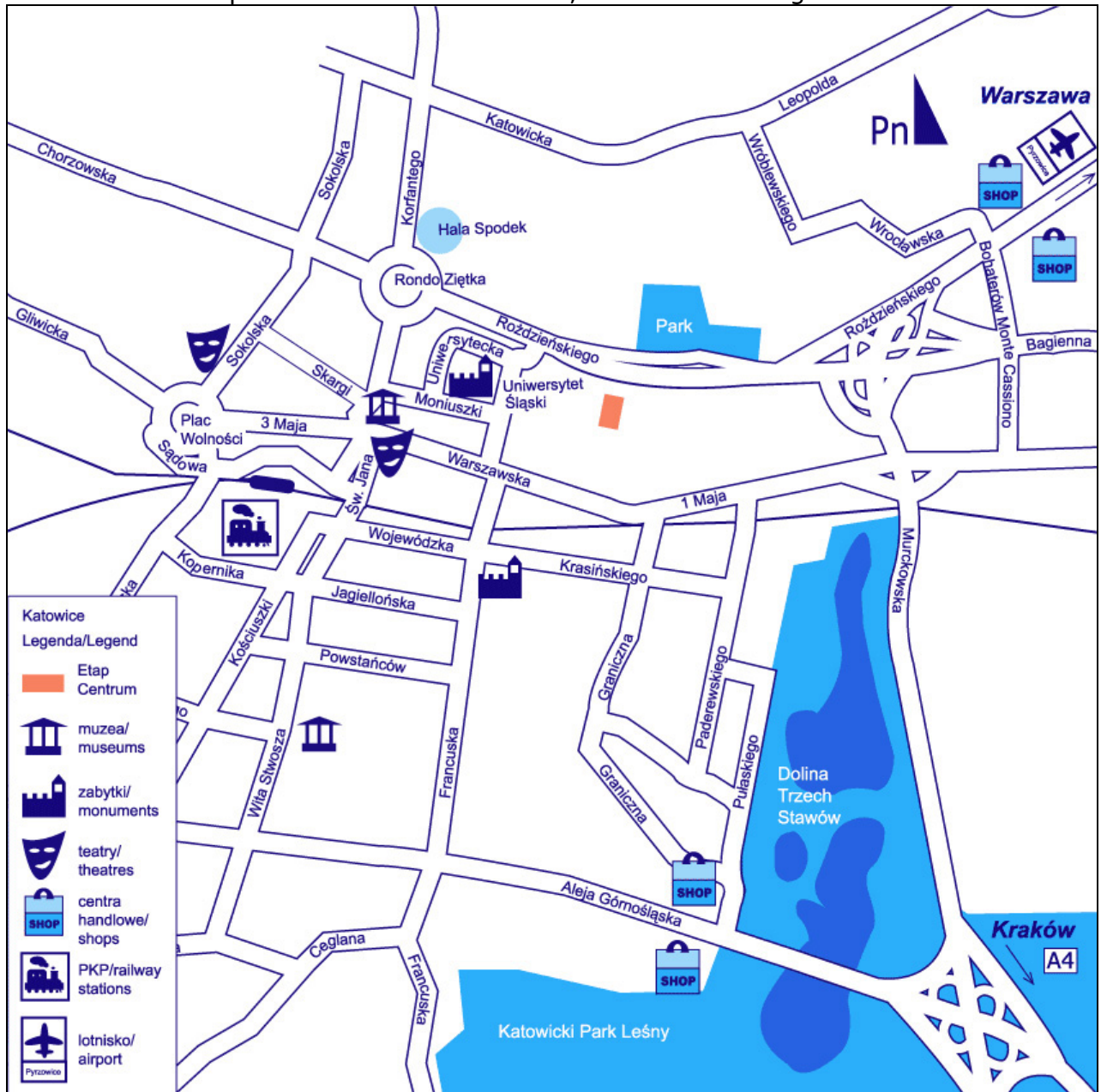
- Debate of the information and consultation chain to identify the good and the weak points
